NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.301226 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$0.301226 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.308092 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City of Kenedy from the same properties in both the 2020 tax year and the 2021 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that the City of Kenedy may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that the City of Kenedy is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 14, 2021 at 6:00 PM at Kenedy City Hall Auditorium, 303 W. Main Street, Kenedy, Texas 78119.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, the City of Kenedy is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the City Council of the City of Kenedy at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

Your taxes owed under any of the above rates can be calculated as follows:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate} \times \text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
